The Stem Cell Game of Life HOW TO PLAY



- 1. Decide who will be the Dealer. All players should have their own game board. Dealer should distribute 6 Stem Cells to each player. Players should place the Stem Cells on the lower of the two gray circles at the top of the board.
- 2. Differentiate! Take turns by going clockwise. The players should all roll the dice to determine what germ layer one of their Stem Cells will join. (1-2 = Mesoderm, 3-4 = Endoderm, 5-6 = Ectoderm)

 Depending on what number the player rolled, the Dealer will trade in a Stem Cell for the respective germ layer cell.
- 3. Differentiate again! The players can decide whether to continue differentiating to the next level (Odd = Left Block, Even = Right Block)
- 4. Continue differentiating until all players have one of each differentiated cell. If players run out of stem cells, they may choose to forgo one of their turns to self-renew and get another stem cell.
